SOWING AND REAPING

Christ's first parable compared seed to the Gospel and soil to those who hear The catalyst required for spiritual growth, being a heart that's totally sincere He longed to open mans hearts and minds so a change would then take place By having them focus on the meaning of His words, God's truths would be their base.

Jesus then likened severely packed soil to people whose hearts are hard Insensitivity causing a lack of understanding with spiritual learning barred Their ears are described as completely deaf, along with eyes that cannot see Wearing hearts so rough and badly calloused, they're unable to hear God's plea.

The Lord next talked about paper thin soil being like a shallow heart Repelled by the cost of following Christ, not allowing deep roots to start Another condition Jesus warned them of was a soil that is filled with weeds A heart that allows a busy earthly life to crowd out the spiritual seeds.

Last, He spoke about the good soil, producing more than the seeds that were sown This an example of a heart that is open, resulting in a faith that has grown These four responses can be from one person; Christians like you and me So ask God in prayer to search your heart, providing wisdom and open eyes that see.
